

1. The Name of the Corporation is: Thornhill Baseball Club
2. Ontario Corporation Number: 000824629

4. Number of Directors: 11
5. Purposes:
 - a. To develop the fundamentals of baseball;
 - b. To provide for all duly registered players an opportunity to participate in the activities of the Corporation regardless of ability; and
 - c. To promote good sportsmanship, behavior and community spirit.
6. Special Provisions
 - a. The corporation shall be carried on without the purpose of gain for its members and any profits or other accretions to the corporation shall be used in promoting its objects.
 - b. The directors shall serve as such without remuneration, and no director shall directly or indirectly receive any profit from his position as such; provided that a director may be paid reasonable expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties.
 - c. To purchase, lease or otherwise acquire lands, buildings, easements and property, real and personal, which may be required for the uprose of or capable of being conveniently used in connection with any of the objects of the corporation.
 - d. Membership: The Corporation has the following category of Member:
 - i. Approved Member – A maximum of twenty-nine (29) individuals who have applied to be Members of the Corporation, and who have been approved as Members of the Corporation by the Board by Ordinary Resolution. The Approved Members will be composed of the following:
 1. Eleven (11) - Directors
 2. Three (3) – Representatives of the Men’s League baseball program
 3. Eight (8) – Representatives of the Youth House League baseball program
 4. Three (3) – Representatives of the Youth Rep League baseball program
 5. Two (2) – Representatives of the Youth Select League baseball program
 6. One (1) – Representative of the leagues Umpires
 7. One (1) – Representative of the Adult Senior Rep baseball program
 - e. Voting Rights – Members in good standing at the time of the meeting of the Members at which a vote is to be taken have the following voting rights at all meetings of the Members:
 - i. Approved Members have one vote each.
 - f. Dissolution – Upon dissolution of the Corporation and after payment of all debts and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed to charitable or not-for-profit organizations which carry on their work solely in the province of Ontario.
